EFry Hope and Help provides trauma-informed, inclusive and gender-responsive programs and services to support women and girls at risk or involved in the legal system in building stable lives.

We are recruiting a full-time Family Homelessness Prevention Worker for the Volaria Program. The successful candidate will support single women and mothers with children in securing and sustaining permanent housing. Using a trauma-informed, gender-responsive, and child-centred approach, the worker ensures families are not invisible in the in-service design and helps break cycles of homelessness.

Reporting to the Manager, the Family Homelessness Prevention Worker must be available to work flexible hours/days.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist women and families in locating, securing, and moving into permanent housing.
- Negotiate with landlords and support subsidy applications.
- Provide ongoing case management to address barriers such as income, childcare, health, and safety.
- Create safe, respectful engagement for women with histories of trauma or cultural needs.
- Support children’s stability by coordinating school continuity, health care, and social inclusion.
- Connect families to community resources, counselling, and supports that strengthen long-term housing stability.
- Advocate for equity, culturally safe services, and gender-responsive housing options.
- Performs other related duties as required.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Minimum 2-year post-secondary education coupled with 1-year experience in related work or combination of work and experience totaling 4 years.
- Experience in housing, social services, or family support.
- Knowledge of Housing First principles and local housing resources.
- Skills in trauma-informed, culturally safe, and gender-responsive practice.
- Strong communication, problem-solving, and advocacy abilities.
- People with lived experience are encouraged to apply

MANDATORY JOB REQUIREMENTS:

- Satisfactory Criminal Record Review (Vulnerable Sector Check).
- Standard First Aid / CPR certification.
- Evidence of a Tuberculosis Test in compliance with the TB Control Program.
- Ability to lift 30 pounds.
- Doctors note of fitness to perform the duties of the job.
- Valid Ontario driver’s license, with satisfactory driving record (**Preferred**).
